## Other Requirements: A "Package Deal"

Each week in class there will be **Assigned Memory and a Weekly Test**. These are Pass/Fail and can be made up at the end of class.

Confirmation fits closely with Worship and **Sunday School Attendance**. Confirmation students are required to attend at least 70% of Sunday School Classes.

Mentoring is a requirement for both the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Classes. In the following weeks a Journal will be distributed to each student with specific questions that will be discussed with an Adult Mentor. **Mentors** will be assigned to each of the Students. Besides the Journal Discussion questions there will 3 meetings of Mentors and students through out the year (Oct 30, Jan 8, March 19). Service Projects, Sermon Notes, Acolyte, attendance at Church and Sunday School and the Winter Retreat (February 12-14) are required for Confirmation.

## Note to Parents:

Please monitor your child's progress. Work with your child. Spend some time going over the material again. Some families chose to read or work through assignments together and to practice memory work together.

## Memory Work:

See it, Say it, Hear it! It can be that easy. Choose a quiet place, read the passage over several times, say it out loud at least 7 times, close book and try to repeat. Find someone to listen to you and correct your mistakes. Choose a regular time for study.
