Traditional Lenten Disciplines

Repentance: "Repent and believe in the gospel" (Mark 1:15). At all times, and especially during Lent, we repent of our sins and receive the forgiveness won by Jesus' death and resurrection.

Prayer: "Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation" (Matthew 26:41). We watch and pray with our Savior as he endures the suffering and shame of the cross for us.

Fasting: "When you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, that your fasting may not be seen by others but by your Father who is in secret" (Matthew 6:17-18). Fasting helps us to remember all that Jesus gave up for our salvation.
